Introduction

In the heart of every true child of God burns the sincere desire for deliverance from un-Christlike behavior patterns and victory over the sin-dominated self-life. However, many found to their dismay that a desire for purity and much prayer for divine forgiveness and help are insufficient to achieve success.

God has provided a powerful weapon for this warfare. It is the Holy Scriptures, coupled with faith. **“Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed thereto according to thy word” (Psalm 119:9).** We are sanctified (cleansed) **“with the washing of water by the word” (Ephesians 5:26).** The Word of God is a cleansing flow for sin, a flaming sword with which to combat the enemy, and an unerring guide to the way of holiness. “Thy word have I hid in mine heart,” wrote the Psalmist, “that I might not sin against thee”(Psalm 119:11).

May you find in this Scripture Notebook a guide to holiness, an encouragement to faith, and a challenge to further pursue the Word of God for practical help in your daily Christian walk. It is set forth as a faith-stimulator. It is basically intended for serious study and reference for prayer needs, as well as tabulations for scripture referral.

Many voices in the world vie for our attention. The Bible is still and will always remain the one final authoritative voice of Truth! May we cherish it in our hearts, hold it in our thoughts and speak it forth in faith. God by His Holy Spirit will keep His promise that it shall not return void.

Since my venture into the ministry of the Word, many testimonies of miraculous healings have been trickling back to me. The amazing results of these healings and testimonials will be a confirmation to you as to the validity of this message and what the Holy Spirit is saying to His children in this day. The Lord has confirmed this message to me day after day since I received my new lease on life in 1969 through His healing power. After Jesus touched me, His ministry to me was an exhortation on how to retain these healings and to continue in good health. Since then, He has exhorted me over and over to "Teach My people My ways!" That which I am relating to you is what the Holy Spirit has made alive in my life. My Scripture Key Notebook evolved through His daily Word to me in my constant endeavor to fill the hunger and thirst I had for the things of God. The notebook entailed seven years of gathering scriptures and it keeps growing as I continue to find new jewels and add to it.

Each person to whom I have ministered has received a Scriptural Key Rx (prescription) to use following the laying on of hands. As they have verbally repeated these verses three times each, four times a day, for the time prescribed, the powers of darkness are overcome. There is no room for doubt or wavering faith if some of the symptoms are still evident (James 1:6-7). The blood of the Lamb and the Word of their testimony has won the battle for them (Revelation 12:11). Anyone can retain a healing if they will do likewise and use the scriptures to ward off the evil powers that would try to rob them of their gifts, miracles from God, the Father. If I have the opportunity, I usually give scriptures which pertain to the particular need of the seeker for healing or deliverance, plus a few 'faith builders' such as: **I Jn. 3:8 "...For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil."**

Jn. 15:7 "If ye abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."

Ps. 84:11 "No good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly."

Prov. 10:11 "The mouth of a righteous man is a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked."

Jer. 1:12b "...I will hasten My Word to perform it."

Ps. 138:2b “...thou hast magnified Thy Word above all thy name.”

Num. 23:19 “God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that He should repent: hath He said, and shall He not do it?...”

Ps. 89:34 “My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.”

Rom. 8:2 “For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.”

Rom. 8:11 “...He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.”

Ps. 107:20 “He sent His Word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.”

SKIN DISEASE - CANCER

Our Heavenly Father does not always allow us to see or to know the results of our ministry. I believe He protects us from the sin of vain glory by keeping most of these results from us until He knows that we know how to give all the glory to Him. One of the first miracles which was called to my attention was related to me by a pastor in Tampa, Florida. We had come into contact soon after at a Crusade where He related this testimony to me. One of the women who had received scriptures for skin and eyes had cancer. This was unknown to me at the time. I gave her **Proverbs 4:20-22** for her skin and **Isaiah 35:5** and **32:3** for her eyes, through the leading of the Holy Spirit. She repeated these scriptures three times each, four times a day in the following manner: Once to God, thanking Him; once to the devil, prefacing it with, “It is written”; and once to herself, prefacing it with “I believe.” After persevering for two weeks in this way, cancers began to drop off her skin from all over her body because she continued to speak out these scriptures just as the Lord had led me to exhort her. The word, ‘health’ in **Proverbs 4:22** in Hebrew means medicine. Truly, these verses were medicine to her! The next miracle occurred in the life of a young girl named Donna who had a staph infection on her feet, hands and face. These were running, open and ugly sores. After she heard about the first lady’s miracle, she decided she would speak these same scriptures out all day long. On the

following day after, all these eruptions were dried up! Staph is a germ which does not readily respond to medication and often is very difficult to be rid of. Three days later, the Lord told me to give these same scriptures to a young woman who was sitting in front of me in church. After inquiring as to whether she had any skin problems, she related that everyone in her household had impetigo. She took the same advice from me and on the following Wednesday at church she said that scabs were popping off everyone in the family.

INSOMNIA

A return engagement to the First Methodist Church of Tarpon Springs, Florida brought the following testimony to my attention: a woman of about sixty five years of age, came to me with tears in her eyes and said, “I used to take sleeping pills every night of my life to sleep, but now I take the scriptures you gave us the last time you ministered here. I sleep like a baby now for the first time in years.” The verses she was referring to are: **Psalm 4:8; Isaiah 29:10; Psalm 127:2b and Proverbs 3:24.**

SUNBURN

A return engagement to another area showed many believers were appropriating and standing on God’s Word for many different kinds of blessings. They passed scriptures around among themselves for different kinds of needs. One woman could never enjoy her husband’s company in their boat because she would be burned seriously by the sun every time they took their boat to the lake. She decided to heed what I said during my last visit there and used **Isaiah 49:10; Psalm 107:20 and Psalm 121:6.** She quoted these scriptures frequently during the next boat ride and did not receive any sunburn; praise the Lord!

BONES, BURNS

Another lady was so excited about using scriptures in this way that her enthusiasm affected her whole family. They came for scriptures because they saw the results she was having with her daily use of God’s Word. One daughter applied **Psalm 6:2, “Oh Lord, heal me; for my bones are vexed.”** and **Psalm 34:20, “He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken,”** when she broke her thumb and could not swim in the next swim meet per doctor’s orders. I understand that she did swim in that next meet,

so there must have been a change of plans! Another child in the same family was badly burned on her legs as she and a boyfriend motorcycled through some hot ashes without being aware of their presence. She phoned her mother long distance for the burn scriptures. She had immediate relief from the pain as she spoke these scriptures in prayer. There was not any sign of infection following. Pain is released by applying **Isaiah 53:4**.

LOST ARTICLES

The woman whom God has used to bring about this notebook has also seen some unusual results in Israel. She came to my home to stay with me and there lost a large diamond out of her ring. We scoured the place, swept the floors, looked in the garbage, *etc.* all the while claiming Matthew 10:26: **“For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.”** Even though a few days had already gone by, she had witnessed to an unbelieving Jew about this, and how God’s Word would be performed. Whenever she doubted, she said, “bring into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ, oh Lord!” (**II Corinthians 10:5**). Her faith and trust in God was rewarded! One morning, one week later, I heard her scream out, “My diamond, my diamond!” There it was on the floor, glittering in the sunlight. Remember, the floor had been swept carefully! Little things like this show the love and care of our heavenly Father (**I Peter 5:7**).

NERVE SEVERED

A middle-aged lady in my brother’s apartment building had surgery during which the surgeon had accidentally severed the nerves controlling her bowels. When the doctor told her there was nothing they could do about it, no way to alleviate this condition, and also that she would have to learn to live with it, she said, “I would rather be dead!” She came to me for prayer the next day after my brother had urged her. We laid hands on her and believed for her healing after anointing her with oil. She was given a Scripture Key Rx to speak out as prescribed, four times a day, three times, each verse. The following Saturday, four days later, she related to my brother that there were no more signs of her condition. Only God can put nerves back together! Praise Him for this beautiful miracle! Her faith to believe for her complete deliverance from this condition was fortified by her spiritual prescription. Even though these are the foolish things of God (**I Corinthians 1:25**), they

have brought miracles! We so rejoiced and praised the Lord with her because her testimony gave impetus to drawing many others into believing God for miracles, including her own family. See “My Personal Daily Rx” plus **Proverbs 4:20-22**.

NERVE DISEASE

A former missionary was ministered deliverance and the laying on of hands for a nerve disease. This disease gave her much distress and pain all over her body. Again, the Lord led me to give her a scriptural prescription. A word of prophecy came through the mouth of another servant of the Lord exhorting her to continue in the use of her Rx as directed. She was given healing scriptures plus post-deliverance scriptures to ward off any attempt of the enemy to harass her ‘after her house was swept clean.’ When I saw her weeks later, she said she had not had any more pain and that she felt just great! We just praised the Lord together because He had ministered to the needs of His servant. This woman received the following Rx: **Romans 8:2** and **11**; **Isaiah 53:4a**; **John 14:27**; **Psalm 107:2** and **20**; **Psalm 55:18**; **Psalm 17:4** and **Revelation 12:11** for maintenance of the healing and deliverance (**John 14:27**- Greek is Peace for body).

BED WETTING

While ministering in a church in the south, I met a mother who had a twelve year old son who was still wetting the bed nightly. The boy had received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit at a crusade conference but was still having this problem. The scriptures for bed wetting, **Psalm 144:7**; **25:20**; **32:6b**, were given to his mother along with supportive scriptures: **John 8:32, 36**; **Psalm 107:2**. That night she and her son knelt by his bed together and placed their prayers and supplications before the Throne of Grace repeating the ‘bed wetting’ scriptures and identifying with them personally. The next morning they really rejoiced together, thanking the Lord for answering their petitions. There was no sign of that condition from that day on because they had accepted his deliverance, trusting God’s Word to work. **“God sent His Word and healed him, and delivered him from his destructions” (Psalm 107:20)**.

BUSINESS NEEDS

While visiting a dear sister named Ebbie, business problems began to show up and they were robbing her of her peace. Knowing how the devil tries to rob the Spirit-filled believer, we began to claim the following scriptures together in agreement: **Joshua 1:8; Psalm 35:27; 46:1; 55:22; Isaiah 41:10** and **III John 2**.

The next day, the problems completely disappeared without any explanation! God had undertaken! Even the mechanical problems had been alleviated without any plausible reason. Together, we had the power of agreement, (**Matthew 18:19**) and God's wonderful promises to stand on. Not only were the problems overcome, but God gave an increase in every endeavor of business in which this sister was involved in at that time.

God has given mankind the Word to use daily: to direct, instruct, protect, heal, deliver, cleanse, convict, create, console, and to bring about the most precious gift of all-Salvation! "For I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth;..." **Romans 1:16**). The Word is the seed which opens the heart to receive Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord. "...With the mouth confession is made unto salvation" (**Romans 10:9-10**).

SALVATION FOR FAMILY

In 1973 I gave certain scriptures to a lovely lady by the name of Norah who worked in a Bible book store in Clearwater, Florida. She related to me how she had been praying for her husband's salvation for five years. I began to share with her the scriptural way to receive results for anything if you are a believer; especially salvation for those on your heart. With joyful anticipation and praise, she attended to God's Word as directed. Later, she told me that she began to pray for her husband's salvation on November 3, 1973. She inscribed this date in her Bible by each scripture which I gave her. The following February 28th, her husband was saved and baptized in the Holy Ghost. The secret of the quick results is trusting God to do the work; this means to keep quiet and not to make one inference about your beliefs or ideas. If inquiries are made, be minimal in your conversations. God will begin to work right before your eyes bringing you a complete joy when you see Him "hasten His word to perform it". There is a way and it works, if you believe, for God honors His Word and uses the foolish things of the world to confound the wise (**I Corinthians 1:25-28**). So, don't falter

... persevere no matter what circumstances come up before your eyes. God is faithful to His Word.

Before I go on, there should be a stipulation set forth here. If the one for whom you are praying has already received the heavenly gift, the Baptism of the Holy Ghost, and yet this one has apparently gone back to the ways of the world, then much, much more effort will have to be taken on your part. Fasting and prayer will break the bands of wickedness. Not many people in the Bible were able to change God's mind! Two of the very few who are recorded in the Bible were Hezekiah and Ahab. They humbled themselves before God and God did change His mind. If you know how wicked Ahab was and that at that time no grace was available, you will have a vivid picture of the mercy of God. God is not willing that any perish. He desires all men to come into salvation. He states, "For I am the Lord, I change not..." therefore, His Word cannot change either (**Matthew 24:35**). The Word states, "**Him that cometh to Me, I will in no wise cast out**" (**John 6:37; Hebrews 7:25**). So fast and pray for this one to acknowledge the error of his ways and repent of his wrong doing, so the glorious light of the Gospel will draw him back into fellowship with God. "**For with God nothing shall be impossible**" (**Luke 1:37**).

FOR SALVATION AND THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Use the following verses in each situation, applying them to the person for whom you are praying by putting their name in each scripture. Speak these selected scriptures out loud. If necessary, write them down on a piece of paper and read them to the Lord (Hosea 14:2). Soon after, you will notice that those scriptures will become a part of you because memorization comes from repeating verses often. (All these references are to verses printed out under title page, "Salvation".) **Step 1: Acts 16:31**

Believe- (For family members)

The Word says it, so this belongs to you!

Step 2: Colossians 4:3 (*KJV only*)

Door of Utterance

The door of utterance is opened by the Holy Spirit to speak the mystery of Christ by the witness of another (other than yourself). They will plant the seed of the Word in their heart for the Holy Spirit to

water and nourish. Then the mystery of Christ will be revealed because their spiritual eyes will have been opened by the Holy Spirit to receive the indwelling Word. If you leave this all to Jesus, He will do a much faster job and in doing so, will bring all the glory to God.

Scriptures following and including this step can be used for whomever, as well as family.

Step 3: Matthew 5:6

Hunger and Thirst

Only the Lord Jesus can give them this hunger for spiritual things and more of Him.

Step 4: John 6:44; 14:6

Drawn unto the Father

Drawing power is part of God's omnipotence (all-power). Only God the Father can draw them into submission by His Spirit (**John 1:12-13**).

Step 5: Psalm 37:4-5

Committal

This is the key to the success of the whole plan. When someone is committed to the Lord, he must be left in the Lord's hands. If you start fretting, questioning, worrying, you are not trusting God, and you get it back in your hands - God's hands are tied by your unbelief. Faith is believing you receive before you see it (**Hebrews 11:1**).

From this point on, you will see the devil try to work in a stronger, more evident way, if you are around the one for whom you are praying. The devil wants you to doubt and waver so your prayer will not be answered, **"A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken"** (**Proverbs 15:13**).

Don't let the devil break your spirit! Remember, verbalizing God's promises is joining your faith to your confession. **"That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus"** (**Philemon 6**). God has begun His work, so *from the day of committal, there is no need to ask anymore. Begin to thank Him each day, repeating each scripture key as you apply it to the person for whom you are praying.* As you repeat the Word each day, you are holding **'fast your profession'** (**Hebrews 4:14b**) and believing you have received even before the evidence

is before your eyes and ears (**II Corinthians 4:13**). *Do not stop thanking God each day in each scripture key* unto you see the results come forth!

SCRIPTURE KEYS FOR CONFIDENCE AND ASSURANCE

(To carry you through)

Ps. 34:10b “They that seek the Lord shall not want any good thing.”

It certainly is a good thing to desire someone’s salvation!

Ps. 37:4 “Delight thyself also in the Lord; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart.”

Prov. 10:24b “...the desire of the righteous shall be granted.”

Isa. 55:11 “So shall My word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto me void,...”

Eph. 3:20 “Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,” (That power is evident when professing God’s Word).

Rom. 4:20-21 “He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.”

“Faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the Word of God.”

Romans 10:17

“But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him” (Hebrews 11:6). As you use God’s Word daily, you are taking God at His Word! So many answers to prayer do not come because God will not violate His Word. Faith is a necessary ingredient. By using His Word in prayer and supplication with thanksgiving as instructed herein, God will honor it. Why? One of the reasons is because your faith is being built up as you speak His Word. This is asking in faith (Romans 10:17). If you did not believe the Word, you would not be applying it to your prayers. The crying and begging without faith gets no farther than the ceiling in your room. Faith is a gift of God, (**Ephesians 2:8**) and cOnfessing the Word brings the faith needed for each situation. As you speak it, the Word becomes flesh in you bringing belief. Belief activates the miracle-working faith!

HINDRANCES

There can be hindrances to receiving answers to prayer and healings. If you are not seeing results, either you have not persevered long enough or there is a hindrance blocking it. Do not allow doubt to invade your conversation, or into your heart. Believe, and give it time, knowing that God will not let His Word return unto Him void. Under Hindrances Blocking Answers, there is a list to examine if you are concerned as to why answers are not forthcoming.

REMEMBER

There are immediate answers. **“And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear” (Isaiah 65:24).**

There is waiting patiently, believing, and thanking God every day for the answer which came the moment you asked, but sometimes we have to wait, like Daniel did. God’s time and His way of answering may not be the way or time we expect it, but the answer will come, for “nothing is impossible with God” (luke 18:27; Ezekiel 12:21-28).

If there never is an answer, maybe God has a reason for not answering this prayer. Many have had the experience of thanking God that He sees ahead,

knowing that if we had knowledge of the future, we would not pray that prayer. We should not apply this to a salvation request, for **“God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance” (II Peter 3:9).**

Doubt is a robber! (James 1:6-7)

Doubt is an outright distrust of the love and care of the Heavenly Father and this is a SIN! **“Cast thy burden upon the lord, and He shall sustain thee: He shall never suffer the righteous to be moved” (Psalm 55:22).** The devil would like to rob you of every blessing: disbelief, fear, worry, and confusion are all mixed up with doubt. **“Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the lord, which He will shew to you today:...” (Exodus 14:13).** **“God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind” (II Timothy 1:7).**

ABSENTMINDEDNESS

Prov. 16:3 “Commit thy works unto the Lord, and thy thoughts shall be established.”

I sa. 50:7a “For the Lord God will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded...”

Jn. 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.”

I Cor. 2:16b “...But we have the mind of Christ.”

BINDING AND LOOSING - The Keys to the Kingdom of God

One of the greatest weapons believers have for the battle between the enmity of the flesh, the soul, and the spirit; the warfare which goes on in the mind (II Corinthians 10:4-5). All evil can be bound in the name of Jesus, but, one must remember, it is our use of the powers of God delegated to us in the name of Jesus which overcomes the evil with Good! In prayer, think of opposites, such as: pain vs. peace; faith vs. fear; confusion vs. clarity of mind, *etc.*

Mt. 6:33 “But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

Rom. 14:17 “For the Kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.”

Mt. 6:9-13 The Lord’s Prayer “...Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven...”

This is here and now, and not later.

Rev. 1:6 “And hath made us kings and priests unto God and His See 5:10 & Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and 20:6 ever. Amen.”

Kings carry out the business of the kingdom. They are its executives.

Eph. 1:20-23 “...And hath put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fulness of Him that filleth all in all.”

Eph. 2:6 “And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:”

All things are put under our feet. The feet are not disconnected from the head.

Ps. 118:8-11 “It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in man ... All nations compassed me about: but in the name of the Lord will I destroy them. They compassed me about; yea, they compassed me about; but in the name of the Lord I will destroy them.”

Ps. 146:6-9 “Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two edged sword in their hand; (see Heb. 4:12) To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people; TO BIND THEIR KINGS WITH CHAINS, and their nobles with fetters of iron; To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints...”

Lk. 10:19 “Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

Jn 14:13-14 “And whatsoever ye shall ask IN MY NAME, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son...”

Mt. 12:28 “But if I cast out (spirits) devils by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God is come unto you.” (Also Lk. 11:20).

Mk. 3:26-27 “And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end. No man can enter into a strong man’s house, and spoil his goods, except he will FIRST BIND the strong man; ..• “

In the name of Jesus, we can paralyze the strong man. The devil is mighty, for he has angelic powers, but God’s power is Almighty! Man cannot resist the powers of darkness unless he has a greater power dwelling within him (I John 4:4).

Mt. 11:12 “...until now the Kingdom of Heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.”

Mt. 16:18-19 “...upon this rock I will build My Church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven:”

This is executive authority over the kingdom business here on this earth. What are the keys?

“And whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.”

Mt. 18:18-20 “Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven...” Both these last two

scriptures are contained in one Gospel! Do you think Jesus was trying to get an important message across?

Lk. 12:31-32 Repeat of Matthew 6:33.

“Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father’s good pleasure TO GIVE YOU THE KINGDOM.” Lk. 10:9 “And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, the Kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.”

Jn. 14:15,21, “If ye love me, keep my commandments ... If a man 23-24 love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him...”

Binding and loosing is a command! It is building the Church of God Almighty by moving into the devil’s territory. Where do you think these souls came from? They have been held in captivity by the powers of darkness. After our Lord was crucified, He descended into the bowels of the earth to preach to the captives held there by death; he took the keys from the devil, loosed the prisoners in ‘Abraham’s bosom’ from captivity and then led them up to glory with Him. The Lord left us these keys to unlock the gates of hell and the authority in His name to continue the work of building His Church. We became solid living stones in that Church when we make use of the tools, His commandments, in our day by day experience. Then, we automatically begin to add to the church daily through augmenting these commands.

This is where the Kingdom of God begins to become a place where the redeemed of the Lord live; in righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost (Romans 14:17).

Begin to bind all the powers of darkness which come against you and loose all the powers of heaven which are at your disposal, in the name of Jesus. Binding and loosing go together as the Word says! To bind is to bind something up so it cannot move. To loose is to turn something loose. So bind the evil and loose the opposite, the greater powers of God-His fruits, His gifts, His ministering spirits, *etc.* “Greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world” (I John 4:4). These greater powers are those of God Almighty through His Holy Spirit dwelling in you. They dispel the powers of darkness.

THE BLOOD OF JESUS - What it gives to us freely

SALVATION An act of being born again; being saved from eternal damnation.

Jn. "...Verily, verily, I say unto thee, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Jn. 3:17 "For God sent NOT his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved."

Acts 4:12 "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."

ATONEMENT That which blots out or covers over the sins of mankind.

Lev. 17:11 "For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the BLOOD THAT MAKETH AN ATONEMENT FOR THE SOUL."

Rom. 5:11 "And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement."

REDEMPTION The contract on our life is paid in full, bought back from the power of sin and death.

Ps. 107:2 "Let the redeemed of the Lord SAY SO, whom He hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;"

Eph. 1:7 "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;"

Rev. 5:9 "...Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood..."

JUSTIFICATION We have been acquitted of guilt and sin.

Rom. 5:9 "Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him."

Acts 13:38 “Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:”

Acts 13:39 “And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.”

RIGHTEOUSNESS We are put back into right-standing with God (Isaiah 59:2) and continually as, I John 1:9.

Rom 3:22 “Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is its difference:”

Rom. 3:23 “For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;”

Rom. 3:25 “Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;”

SANCTIFICATION We are set apart unto God, at salvation as well as each day after, through the blood of Jesus.

I Cor. 1:30 “But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:”

Heb. 10:10 “By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.”

Heb. 10:14 “For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.”

REMISSION The debt and guilt of sin has been cancelled.

Rom. 3:24 “Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:” **Rom 3:25** “...to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past...”

RECONCILED When we change our attitude and accept God’s provision, we change from hostility towards God to fellowship and love for Him.

Col. 1:20 “And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself;...”

Rom. 5:10 “For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.”

OVERCOMING That which we receive when we appropriate what has

POWER been delegated unto us.

Lk. 10:19 “Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

Rev. 12:11 “And they (Christians) overcame him (the devil) by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.”

DELIVERED We are released from powers of darkness, set at liberty from captivity.

II Cor. 1:10 “Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that **HE WILL YET DELIVER US;**”

Col. 1:13 “Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:”

FORGIVENESS The act of forgiving, having pardoned and forgotten.

Col. 1:14 “In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:”

I Jn. 1:9 “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

WHY PLEAD THE BLOOD OF JESUS?

For Reference: *The Power in the Blood* by Maxwell Whyte

Lev. 9:12 “And he slew the burnt offering; (type of Jesus, the Lamb) and Aaron’s sons presented unto him the blood, which he sprinkled round about upon the altar” (Type of Cross) (The shedding of blood for the forgiveness of sins was part of the whole plan of worship ordained by God and revealed unto Moses. It was a foreshadowing of Jesus’ sacrifice upon the cross for the redemption of man (see **Leviticus 17:11; Hebrews 9:22**).

Lev. 9:18 “...which was for the people: and Aaron’s sons presented unto him the blood, which he sprinkled upon the altar round about,”

(Jesus’ blood was sprinkled all over Himself and round about the cross).

Lev. 9:24 “And there came a fire out from before the Lord, and consumed upon the altar the burnt offering and the fat: which when all the people saw, they shouted, and fell on their faces.”

(What effect did the blood have upon all the people? It drove away every evil spirit from their midst!)

Lev. 14:25 (Here the blood is applied where evil will try to take ground).

Num. 19:4 (Blood is sprinkled seven times. The number seven indicates “completion.” Jesus was the “final sacrifice.”) **Heb. 9:19** “For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people.”

Heb. 11:28 “Through faith he kept the passover, and the SPRINKLING OF BLOOD, lest He that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.”

Heb. 12:24 “And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to THE BLOOD OF SPRINKLING, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.”

I Pet. 1:2 “Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, UNTO OBEDIENCE and sprinkling of THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST:...”

I Jn. 5:8-9 “And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, AND THE BLOOD: and these three agree in one. If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater:...”

By faith, our inheritance includes the sprinkling of the blood of Jesus. As believers, we are to obey the law of the “sprinkling of the blood,” knowing the power in the blood *overcomes all evil*.

BOLDNESS

Ps. 110:3a “Thy people shall be willing in the day of Thy power,...”

Prov. 28:1b “...but the righteous are bold as a lion.” **Mt. 10:19** “But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.” (Note: Read Matthew 10:19-20.) **Lk. 21:14-15** “Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.”

Eph. 3:11-12 “According to the eternal purpose which He purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord: In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of Him.”

Eph. 6:19 “And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,”

Phil. 1:20 “According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death.”

Heb. 4:16 “Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.”

(Note: Read **Hebrews 4:14-16**.)

Col. 1:13 “Who hath (past tense) delivered us (believers) from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son.”

Eph. 1:3 “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who hath blessed us with ALL spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:”

Eph. 6:12 “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in HIGH PLACES (heavenly places-atmospheric =aer (Greek)). There are many heavens, terrestrial, celestial, heavens of the heavens, and the throne of God. Satan is the prince of the power of the air, (Eph. 2:2), the god of this world (II Cor. 4:4). Jesus placed believers far above the powers of Satan and his powers of darkness.

Eph. 1:21 “Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and EVERY NAME THAT IS NAMED, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: 22 And HATH PUT ALL THINGS UNDER HIS FEET (it was accomplished at the Cross) and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church” (the body of believers, YOU! Are the feet separated from the head?) **Eph. 2:6 “And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.”** (Does Jesus Christ sit in the midst of the kingdom of darkness? NO! He sits above it and we do, also, as His body).

Eph. 1:19 “And what is the exceeding greatness of His power to usward WHO BELIEVE, according to the working of His mighty power.”

20 “Which He wrought in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and set Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places.”

Mk. 16:17 “And these signs shall follow them that believe; IN MY NAME (THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST) SHALL THEY CAST OUT DEVILS: they shall speak with new tongues;” (See Baptism of the Holy Spirit) Believers have the authority over all the powers of darkness, delegated to them in the name of Jesus.

Lk. 10:19 Jesus said, “Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means harm you.” (Doesn’t this put devils and demons under your feet?) **Mt. 28:18 “...All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye...”** (power is given to ALL, not just ministers or a select few.) **Jas. 4:7 “Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and HE WILL FLEE from you.”** (flee, as terror-stricken!)

DELIVERANCE

Ex. 15:6 “Thy right hand, O Lord, is become glorious in power: Thy right hand, O Lord, hath dashed in pieces the enemy.”

Job 36:15 “He delivereth the poor in his affliction, and openeth their ears in oppression.”

The minister needs the Baptism of Holy Ghost to have power over any demon!

Lk. 9:1-2 “Then He called His twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils,...”

Lk. 10:19 “Behold I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.”

A follower of Jesus Christ is a disciple: Greek = *learner*.

Acts 10:38 “How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil;...”

Mt. 8:16b “...He cast out the spirits WITH HIS WORD,...”

Jesus placed importance and emphasis on the power of the spoken word.

Gen.1:3 “And God said,”...CREATION BEGAN ON THE WORD.

Jn. 1:1 “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.”

Mk. 11:23 “For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall SAY unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things WHICH HE SAITH shall come to pass; HE SHALL HAVE WHATSOEVER HE SAITH.”

There is the same power in our words, especially if the Holy Scriptures are spoken in the situation, just as Jesus did in the wilderness to overcome the devil's work.

Ps. 107:2 “Let the redeemed of the Lord SAY so, whom He hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;”

We are redeemed from sin, poverty, and sickness, through the atonement (Galatians 3:13-14, 29).

Mt. 8:28-34 Jesus allowed the demons to find their own place; but he told them to leave the person involved with calm assurance. Demons are usurpers and have no right in God's children, so we have the right to deliverance.

Mt. 12:29 "...except he first bind the strong man..."

Mt. 16:19 "And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

Bind and loose audibly-Bind evil spirits. Loose the opposite, the greater powers of God: fruits, gifts *etc.* (I John 4:4).

Rom. 10:10 "For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." Salvation brings deliverance with it!

Rom. 10:17 "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God."

Ps. 17:4 "...by the Word of thy lips I have kept me from the paths of the destroyer."

By the words of thy lips - by God's words.

Jn. 14:23 "...If a man love me, HE WILL KEEP MY WORDS: and my Father will love him, and he will come unto him, and make our abode with him."

Jn. 15:7-8 "If ye abide in me and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples."

This is the secret of a victorious life over all the powers of evil, "My words abide in you," then ask what ye will and it shall be done. This is how we bring glory to the Father and bear fruit for Him as His disciples! The power of God can be loosed through our obedience to the Word of God because He hastens His word to perform it! (Jeremiah 1:12; Ezekiel 12:28).

DISCOURAGEMENT AND DISAPPOINTMENTS

Deut. 31:6, 8 “Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee...”

Ps. 107:19 “Then they cry unto the Lord in their trouble, and He saveth them out of their distresses.”

Isa. 41:10 “Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness.”

Isa. 41:13 “For I the Lord thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.”

Mt. 6:33 “But seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath CALLED US TO PEACE” (not hell).

I Cor. 7:27 “Art thou bound unto a wife? Seek not to be loosed. Art thou loosed from a wife? Seek not a wife.”

I Cor. 7:28 “But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you.”

I Cor. 7:39 “The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will;...”

If marriage and divorce was before you were ‘born again’ and baptized in the Holy Spirit, then:

II Cor. 5:17 “Therefore if any man (or woman) be in Christ, he (or she) is a new creature: old things are passed away; BEHOLD ALL THINGS ARE BECOME NEW.”

(Your whole life, including your marriage and divorce is under the blood, never to be remembered any more by God, just as your worldly life in the flesh is under the blood. Why hang the grave clothes of the ‘old man’ on the ‘new man’? Your whole past life is under the atonement and redeemed by the blood of Jesus. You are a new creature in Christ Jesus!) **Isa. 43:18-19 “Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it?...”**

See MARRIAGE for exercising temperance over desires

FAITH

Mt. 9:29 “...According to your faith be it unto you.” (Truth applied)

Mt. 15:28b “...O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt...” (Our will is involved, too!) **Mt. 21:21** “...Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed ... it shall be done.”

Rom. 1:17 “...The just shall live by faith.”

Rom. 5:1 “Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:”

God cannot work if we do not forgive our children for ungodly ways. They also need to learn about God’s grace, mercy and forgiveness through their experiences in life. Your believing and trusting God’s Word will draw them into submission to the Lord’s will much sooner (*Mt. 12:37; Rom. 2:1; Prov. 18:21).

CHILDREN INVOLVED IN FALSE RELIGIONS AND DOCTRINES OF DEVILS, EASTERN RELIGIONS WITH GURUS, HARE KRISHNA OR DR. MOON:

Parents can claim their children’s deliverance through:

Gal. 3:13-14 “Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles, through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.”

Because they are the seed of the righteous (you as a believer in the Lordship of Jesus Christ) they are redeemed from the curse of this law: **Deut. 28:18, 32, 41** “**Cursed shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy land, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep. Thy sons and thy daughters shall be given UNTO ANOTHER PEOPLE, and thine eyes shall look, and fail with longing for them all the day long: and there shall be no might in thine hand. Thou shalt beget sons and daughters, but thou shalt not enjoy them; for they shall go into captivity.**”

** See: Binding and Loosing*

“In the name of Jesus, I bind: the curse of the law placed on _____ and loose: the redemption Jesus paid for in full for _____ Thank God and continue to praise Him for the immediate release of ____ from error and false religions.

FEAR

This is one of the strong ways in which Satan controls mankind. The Sword of the Spirit spoken in utterance will destroy this “strong man” of the devil when applied often. Once is not enough! In Mark 11:23, the word, “saith” in Greek means, “continuous action,” continuously saying!

Deut. 31:8 “And the Lord, He it is that doth go before thee; He will be with thee, He will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: FEAR NOT, NEITHER BE DISMAYED.”

Ps. 23:4 “Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me.”

Ps. 27:1 “The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?” Ps. 34:4 “I sought the Lord, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.”

Ps. 91:5 “Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;”

Prov. 18:10 “The Name of the Lord is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe.”

Isa. 41:10 “Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness.”

Mt. 28:20 “...lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world.”

FEAR OF MAN

FEAR OF THE LORD

What It is NOT:

Natural fear: for body's protection.

Religious fear: bondage to tradition, images, icons, holy water, men's precepts. **Isa. 29:13-14.**

Demonic fear: torments and enslaves, **II Tim. 1:7; I Jn. 4:18.**

Fear of man: **Isa. 51:7, 12; Prov. 29:25; Heb. 13:6; Ps. 56:11.** Bind this spirit and loose: holy boldness for obedience, faith, confidence or inner strength through Christ. Remember, **"Do all in the name of Jesus ... (Col. 3:17).**

What It Is: (Results capitalized)

Deut. 4:10 "...Gather me the people together, and I will make them hear my words, that they may learn to fear me all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children."

Deut. 5:29 "O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always THAT IT MIGHT 8& WELL WITH THEM, and with their children for ever!"

Deut. 17:19 "And it shall be with Him; and He shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the Lord his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:"

Deut. 17:20 "That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren ... that H& MAY PROLONG HIS DAYS IN HIS KINGDOM, he, and his children,..." Ps. 25:12 "What man is he that feareth the Lord? FORGIVENESS

Unforgiveness forms a “root of bitterness” (Hebrews 12:14-15).

Isa. 55:7 “Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and He will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.”

Mt. 6:14-15 “For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.”

Mt. 18:35 “So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.”

Mk. 11:25-26 “And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses...” (Otherwise, you are not ‘discerning the Lord’s Body’ before you take communion). “...For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.” (I Cor. 11:29-30).

Jn. 20:23 “Whose soever sins ye remit, (forgive) they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained” (by you!). A spirit of unforgiveness takes root.

Beam out forgiveness to those who have harmed or hurt you. Ask God to forgive them and have mercy upon them in a unilateral declaration just as Jesus said on the Cross. The reconciling power of the Cross will bring about miracles in that very hour (See: **Col. 1:20; II Cor. 5:18-20; Isa. 53:5**, this peace speaks about rest, health, and wholeness because relationships are at peace).

“OUT OF THE ABUNDANCE OF THE HEART THE MOUTH SPEAKETH.” (Mt. 12:34b). When it is hard to forgive, your confession shows what is in your heart. (You still resent what they did). Jesus can do it for you if you put Lk. 23:34 to work. An unforgiving heart robs one of all the blessings of the

Lord as well as health and answers to prayers. Why? You placed these people in the bondage of judgment through your words of condemnation (Prov. 18:21; 12:18, Mt. 12:37) when they originally hurt, offended, harmed or cheated you. Therefore, you have restrained the Holy Spirit from moving in either life. (II Pet. 3:9; Jn. 3:16). When you beam out mercy and forgiveness to them, they are released. You now need to ask God to forgive you for holding them in judgment, no matter how badly they have wronged you, in order for you to be released.

(Rom. 2:1). If you do not, you retain their sin against you in your body and soul! This is what John 20:23 means.

Rom. 12:14 “Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.”

Col. 3:12-13 “...Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.”

Eph. 4:31-32 “Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ’s sake hath forgiven you.

GOD'S PRESENCE IS ALL AROUND US

Ex. 14:19 “And the angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them:” (*Behind you-as a rear guard*) **Ex. 33:14-15** “...My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest.” (verse 14) **Deut. 4:39** “Know therefore this day, and consider it in thine heart, that the Lord He is God in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: there is none else.” (*Above you-to watch over you*) **Deut. 33:27** “The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee;...” (Underneath you-to support you) **Ps. 5:12** “For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.”

Ps. 119:50 “This is my comfort in my affliction: for thy word hath quickened me.”

Isa. 57:19 “I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near, saith the Lord; and I will heal him.”

Jn. 14:27 “Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you:...” This type of ‘peace’ in Greek is peace for the body, in the original Greek interpretation. Therefore, it dispels discomfort and pain.

Rom. 8:11 “But if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead

SHALL ALSO QUICKEN YOUR MORTAL BODIES BY HIS SPIRIT THAT DWELLETH IN YOU.”

Heart Disease

Ps. 27:14 “Wait upon the Lord: be of good courage, and He shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord.” (This is: *to rest*).

Ps. 28:7 “The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise him.”

Ps. 31:24 “Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the Lord.”

Ps. 73:26 “My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever.”

Prov. 4:23 “Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.”

Prov. 17:22 “A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.”

Deut. 28:28-29 “The Lord shall smite thee with madness, and blindness, and astonishment of heart: ... and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save thee.”

According to Gal. 3:13-14, Jesus became a curse for us and redeemed us from this curse of the law; therefore, let the enemy know Ps. 107:2 and I Cor. 2:16 because I Cor. 3:16.

Ps. 25:16 “Turn thee unto me, and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate and afflicted.”

Ps. 25:17 “The troubles of my heart are enlarged: 0 bring thou me out of my distresses.”

Ps. 25:20 “0 keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.”

Ps. 37:7 “Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.” (Matthew 5:11-12).

INTERCESSION (Galatians 6:2; Romans 15:1)

As I have traveled around the world, I see many ministers' and pastors' wives and children being harrassed and tormented with many physical and mental problems. The Lord has burdened me to raise up 'prayer-warriors' in each church body to intercede just for the wife and children of their pastor. The body of Christ is exhorted in the Word to pray for those in authority (I Tim. 2:1-4); therefore, the pastors are covered by much prayer, but the wives are neglected in these petitions. Who does the enemy work on the most? The weaker sex ... Example: Adam and Eve. Why? He wants to destroy the ministry of the Shepherd from within the home. The wives and families need a hedge built up around them; those who will stand in the gap and make up the hedge by daily prayer for them. The Lord also exhorted me to have these 'Prayer-warriors' obtain "The Authority of the Believer" by Kenneth E. Hagin and digest it thoroughly! This teaching must be well understood in order for the intercessors to know how to come against the powers of darkness which are behind all the distress of these families. Will you pray for God to burden hearts within your Church who will follow through with this important ministry, now? (See Delegated Authority also.)

Isa. 58:12 "And they that shall be of Thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and Thou shalt be called, THE REPAIRER OF THE BREACH, THE RESTORER OF PATHS TO DWELL IN."

Isa. 59:16 "And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no INTERCESSOR: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him."

Isa. 64:7 "And there is none that calleth upon Thy name, that stirreth liP himself to take hold of Thee: for Thou hast hid Thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities."

Ezek. 13:5 "YE HAVE NOT GONE UP INTO THE CAPS, NEITHER MADE UP THE HEDGE for the house of Israel to stand in the battle in the day of the Lord."

Ezek. 22:30 "And I sought for A MAN AMONG THEM, THAT SHOULD MAKE UP THE HEDGE, AND STAND IN

THE GAP before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.”

Rom. 8:26-27 “Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.”

JUDGMENT - CRITICISM

Jn, 7:24 “Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.”

Rom. 14:13 “Let us NOT THEREFORE JUDGE ONE ANOTHER ANY MORE: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother’s way.”

I Cor. 4:3-5 “But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged of you, or of man’s judgment: yea, I judge not mine own self. For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord. Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts:...”

I Cor. 5:11-12 “But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a FORNICATOR, OR COVETOUS, OR AN IDOLATOR, OR A RAILER, OR A DRUNKARD, OR AN EXTORTIONER; with such an one no not to eat. For what have I to do to judge them also that are without do not ye judge them that are within”

(Only those transgressions listed in this verse can be judged by believers. This leaves out assumptions and evil surmisings!)

Jas. 2:13 “For he shall have judgment without mercy, that hath shewed no mercy; and mercy rejoiceth against judgment.”

When God allows us to see a fault in another, He is giving us a burden or a Word of Knowledge for that person. It is your opportunity to be an intercessor. Do not use this knowledge to stand in judgment or to criticize. Let the Holy Spirit do the convicting and sanctifying work that needs to be done because you prayed for him. God uses these occasions to teach us His ways and move us into maturity. Those who are spiritual will restore such an one in the spirit of meekness (Galatians 6:1) if the Holy Spirit so directs.

Remember, it took Moses 40 years in his ‘back of the desert’ experience to attain that spirit of meekness (Num. 12:3). God has begun a good work (Phil. 1:6) in that one and is also the author and finisher of his faith. God may not be finished with that brother or sister as yet. Is He finished with any of us? There is a difference between judging and ‘trying the spirits.’ (See the second verse in I Jn, 4:1-2) *Judge: to decree or pronounce adjudged, or to conclude.*

Try: to test, prove, examine, or try in court.

(Not proven guilty as yet).

Do not these following scriptures refute being critical and judgmental?

Rom. 12:10 “Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another.”

I Cor. 10:12 “Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall.”

Eph. 4:32 “And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ’s sake hath forgiven you.”

Rom. 2:1 “Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for WHEREIN THOU JUDGEST ANOTHER THOU CONDEMNEST THYSELF;...”

JUDGING - The Gift of Prophecy

Isa. 8:20 “...if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.”

The Holy Spirit will not tell you one thing in the Word and another in prophecy. Human reasoning can be interjected, which is the spirit of flesh; it has to think before it speaks. The Holy Spirit speaks through the spirit of man and not through his mind.

Prov. 14:15 “The simple believeth every word: but the prudent man looketh well to his going.”

Mt. 7:16-20 “...by their fruits ye shall know them.”

Rom 8:15 “For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear;...”

God is not going to lead us back into fear. A sure word of prophecy will bring light and the conviction of the Holy Spirit, not condemnation.

I Cor. 12:3 “...no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say Jesus is Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.”

It makes Jesus Lord

I Cor. 14:6 “Now brethren, if I come unto you SPEAKING WITH TONGUES, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by REVELATION, or by KNOWLEDGE, or by PROPHESYING, or by DOCTRINE?”

II Pet. 1:20-21 “Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.” The Spirit and the Word agree Rev. 19:10 “...for the testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of prophecy.”

It Glorifies Christ

JUDGING - PROPHETS

The church today accepts pastors, evangelists and teachers; therefore, apostles and prophets must be accepted also if the body of Christ is to become perfect and mature according to: Eph 4:11-16 and I Cor. 12:28-31.

I Jn. 4:1-3 “Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh IS OF GOD: and every spirit that CONFESSETH NOT that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is the spirit of antichrist...”

I Cor. 14:32 “And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.”

**Mt. 7:20-22 “Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.”
(Not gifts)**

The gift of prophecy and the ministry of a prophet have been confused by many. Prophets are not to be judged by man, only their spirit is to be judged by another prophet because God deals with the prophets much more severely than man, if they are false. (See: Deut. 18:19-22; Jer. 14:15; 23:12-40; Ezek. 13:3). God specifically tells man to ‘**touch not His anointed**’ and why (Ps. 105:15; I Sam. 26:9-11; II Chr. 20:20; I Chr. 16:22). Many of God’s faithful servants are hindered from carrying out His commands because of man’s limitations and interpretation of trying the spirits. The spirits must be tried before being judged. God is a Spirit! He chose to use man to speak to man. His prophets are His spokesmen and messengers to the body of Christ and are set in the body *for the perfecting of the saints!* They are groomed and trained by God’s voice in His ways to perform His will. Their ministry is confirmed by the manifestations of the Spirit and with signs and wonders following. The ministry of the prophet does not always edify, comfort, or exhort; it may bring the opposite, but will bring new life if heeded and yielded unto. Did Agabus bring comfort to Paul, Elisha to Gehazi, or Paul to Barjesus? Did all the major and minor prophets of the Old Testament comfort Israel? When the ministry of a prophet is required, God is sending His personal messenger to bring the Word of the

Lord because only God knows the intents of the hearts of men. Also, when one is out of fellowship with God, His holiness does not permit Him to fellowship with that one but because of God's great mercy and love for His crowning glory, mankind, He reaches out to him speaking to him through His prophets. There are many reasons why God uses His prophets. Sometimes a word is needed for direction, or to minister confirmation, exhortation, *etc.* These are God's sovereign moves and should be received as such. In doing so, resurrection, restoration, reconciliation, correction, guidance, consolation, *etc.* can be accomplished by the Father God, through the Holy Spirit-not man! See: **Hebrews 11:32-40; James 5:10.**

The antonym of “obedience” is “resistance;” “submission” is the balancing factor. Eph. 5:21 does not say, “Obey ye one another,” but “Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God” so submission is not always precisely obedience. It means: surrender or yield to; honor and respect; or humbling yourself before in obedience. This I share because I have ministered to people who have divorced because of a wrong interpretation of the teaching, “Submission.” Men who have been wounded through dictatorial or dominating mothers or some woman along life's pathway, have a tendency to put their wives under the bondage of obedience and

do not recognize the damage they are doing to their love relationship.

For Singles, Divorced or Surviving mates:

Ask for the same gift which Paul received in matters of self-control.

I Cor. 7:7 “For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his (or her) proper gift of God,...”

Sometimes I sing and read Psalms to Jesus, sometimes I go through this list with a preface of, “I believe,” and sometimes a big “Thank You” to my Heavenly Father before each verse for the blessings He has given through His Word. Often I finish with such a presence surrounding me that I feel like Ps. 5:12 has literally happened! “For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.”

Jas. 5:15 “And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up;”

Rom. 8:11 “...He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken YOUR mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in YOU.”

PATIENCE

Eccl. 7:8 “Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof; and the patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit.”

Prov. 16:32 “He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.”

Isa. 30:15b “...In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength:...”

Lev. 19:31 “Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD.”

Deut. 7:25-26 “The graven images of their gods shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it unto thee, lest thou be snared therein: for it is an abomination to the Lord thy God. - 7. And he that soweth discord among brethren.”**

Prov. 8:13 “The fear of the Lord is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.” (Note: verse 17) Prov. 13:10 “Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised is wisdom.”

PRIDE VS. MALE EGO

The male ego seems to be pride to some believers but it is not. The male ego is what our God bred into man to catapult his natural desires, motivations and attitudes. His ego makes him want to take the initiative, be the leader, the provider, and the protector of his domain. These are traits God created in all male species of life, therefore an important part of his nature.

Pride is a boastful assurance in one's own resourcefulness eliminating his need of God. It exalts a man and shows a covetousness for adulation, the very opposite of HUMILITY.

PROSPERITY

Job 36:11 “If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.”

Josh. 1:8 “This book of the Law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, ... then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.”

Ps. 1:2-3 “But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in His law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth His fruit in His season; his leaf also shall not wither; and WHATSOEVER HE DOETH SHALL PROSPER.”

Ps. 35:27b “...Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.”

Ps. 84:11b “...no good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly.”

Ps. 92:12 “The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree...”

REBELLION BEGAN IN THE HEART OF LUCIFER (Satan).

Proverbs 17:11 “An evil man seeketh only rebellion: therefore a cruel messenger shall be sent against him.”

I Samuel 15:23 “For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry.”

REBELLION IS DISOBEDIENCE, DISTRUST, AND UNBELIEF of God’s care, love, Holy Word, and promises (See: Daniel 9:1-19; Psalm 107:8-12) Deuteronomy 9:23-24 “Likewise when the Lord sent you from Kadeshbarnea saying, Go up and possess the land which I have given you: then ye rebelled against the commandment of the Lord your God, and ye believed him not, nor hearkened to His voice.”

REBELLION VEXES (GRIEVES) THE HOLY SPIRIT

Isaiah 63:8-10 “For He said, Surely they are My people, children that will not lie: So He was their Saviour ..• in His love and in His pity He redeemed them ..• But they rebelled and vexed His Holy Spirit: therefore He was turned to be their enemy, and He fought against them.”

THE LAW OF DEATH FOR ACTS OF REBELLION:

Deuteronomy 21:18-21

I Corinthians 10:11 “Now all these things happened unto them (Israelites) for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition...

RIGHTEOUSNESS (See the Work of Righteousness- Isaiah 32)

Col. 2:14 God blots out even the proof against us, nailing it to His Son's cross.

Rev. 1:5; I Jn. 1:7 He cleanses them all away by the blood of His Son.

STRENGTH

Deut. 33:25 “Thy shoes shall be iron and brass; and as thy days, so shall thy strength be.”

II Sam. 22:40a “For Thou hast girded me with strength to battle:...”

Ps. 27:14 “Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart:...”

Ps. 28:7 “The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped:...”

The ungodly has a voice which leads the sinner.

This is their own spirit, the spirit of flesh or the spirit of the devil.

Rom. 8:15 “For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear;...”

Only the evil spirit causes fear (II Tim. 1:7).

I Cor. 14:7 “And even things without life giving sound, whether pipe or harp, except they give a distinction in the sounds, how shall it be known what is piped or harped?”

I Cor. 14:10 “There are, it may be, so many kinds of voices in the world, and none of them is without signification.”

Every voice has significance!

I Cor. 14:1:!, Paul says, “I know not the meaning of the voice .. “

Seek out agreement in His Word!

When God guides you or gives you direction, He does not nullify the scriptures, neither will He change them to accommodate that voice!

Heb. 8:10 “...I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: • . .”

I Jn. 2:20 “But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.”

The inward witness of the Spirit is what leads you into all truth and Jesus is the Spirit of Truth!

I Jn. 2:27 “But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, AND IS TRUTH, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in Him” (Jn. 10:27).

Jn. 10:3,27 “...the sheep hear His voice: and He calleth His own sheep by name, and leadeth them out. My sheep hear my voice...”

VOICES - “Was that you, Lord?”

How to know the difference between the Lord’s voice and other voices.

Jn. 10:3,5,27 “He calleth His own sheep by name •• the sheep follow Him, for they know His voice. My sheep hear My voice and I know them and they follow Me.”

Jn. 18:37 “Everyone that is of the Truth knoweth My voice.”

I Cor. 12:3 “No man can say that Jesus is Lord but by the Holy Ghost.”

Rev. 19:10 “The testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of prophecy.”

WHEN THE LORD SPEAKS, the following is evident:

AN INWARD KNOWING. Sometimes He speaks words not familiar to you or not common to your vocabulary (I Corinthians 2:13).

PEACE comes into your soul and you are at rest (John 14:27). TRUSTING with all your heart results (Proverbs 3:5-6).

CONFIDENCE AND ASSURANCE follow (Isaiah 30:15).

AGREEMENT WITH THE WORD OF GOD, the Bible. God will not violate His Word for anyone’s convenience; so the message must be checked with the Bible (II Peter 1:19). CONFIRMATION. God always confirms His words to you, especially in guidance for action (II Corinthians 13:1).

THE LORDSHIP OF CHRIST. Satan may use the word “god,” for he is the “god of this world” (II Corinthians 4:4), but he will not call Jesus Christ “Lord” (I Corinthians 12:3).

CLARITY. Jesus always speaks clearly and in line with His Word, so that you KNOW it is He (II Corinthians 1:20).

WHEN THE DEVIL OR ANOTHER EVIL SPIRIT SPEAKS, the following is evident:

DOUBT, FEAR, DISCOMFORT (II Tim. 1:7; Rom. 8:15-16).

CONFLICT, RESTLESSNESS, NO PEACE (Jas. 3:14-18; Isa. 48:22).

QUESTIONING, WONDERING if it is the Lord (Rom. 14:23).

LACK OF CLARITY, CONFUSION. If you have to “work it out” forget it! Satan is the “author of confusion” not God (Jas. 3:16; I Cor. 14:33).

NEGATION OF THE LORD'S COMMANDS to us personally or through Scripture. When God speaks, Satan soon says the exact opposite, trying to snatch away the Word (Matthew 13:4,18,24-30; Genesis 3:4).

LORDSHIP OF CHRIST DENIED, discounted (I John 4:1-6).

CONDEMNATION, GUILT, DISCOURAGEMENT. Satan brings up sins that have already been confessed, forgiven, and forgotten by God (Romans 8:1; I John 3:20; Revelation 12:10). 132

WHEN THE FLESH-SELF SPEAKS, the following is evident: HESITATION. Self has to think before it speaks. God's Word to us flows easily without any preconceptions due to our carnal mind (Romans 8:5-7; cp. 26-27).

DECEPTION. We can be led astray by our own hearts since we do not fully understand ourselves (Jeremiah 17:9-10). So we must feed on the Word until we become mature (Hebrews 5:12).

DOUBLE-MINDEDNESS. Wanting two opposite things at the same time results in instability (James 1:8). Jesus gives us the "single eye" (Matthew 6:22-23) that chooses the Kingdom first (Matthew 6:33) so that we can really want to do God's will (Philippians 2:13). It is the indwelling Spirit that enables us to do this (John 14:16; 16:13).

UNREGENERATE DESIRES. The voice sounds like our own, with our own inflections and intonations, and speaks of the same old desires that you used to indulge in (James 1:13-16). Such desires arise from the flesh, and we must consider ourselves dead to those desires (Romans 6:1-4).

VISIONS

Num. 12:6-8 “And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, I the Lord will make myself known unto him in a vision, and will speak unto him in a dream. My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house. With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the Lord shall he behold...”

Isa. 33:17 “Thine eyes shall see the King in His beauty: they shall behold the land that is very far off.”

Ezek. 12:21-25 “And the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, ... The days are prolonged, and every vision faileth? Tell them therefore, Thus saith the Lord God; I will make this proverb to cease, and they shall no more use it as a proverb in Israel; but say unto them, The days are at hand and the effect of every vision. For there shall be no more any vain vision nor flattering divination within the house of Israel. For I am the Lord: I will speak, and the word that I shall speak shall come to pass; it shall be no more prolonged...”

Hos. 12:10 “I have also spoken by the prophets, and I have multiplied visions, and used similitudes, by the ministry of the prophets.”

Mt. 5:8 “Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.”

Mt. 11:27 “All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and HE TO WHOMSOEVER THE SON WILL REVEAL HIM.”

Jn. 6:40 “And this is the will of Him that sent me, that EVERY ONE WHICH SEETH THE SON, and believeth on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.”

Jn. 14:21 “He that hath My commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth Me: and he that loveth Me shall be

**loved of my Father, and I will love him, and WILL
MANIFEST MYSELF TO HIM.”**

WEIGHT CONTROL (Dieting Helps)

Mk. 8:34 “...Whosoever will come after Me, let him (or her) deny himself (or herself), and take up his cross, and follow Me.”

Prov. 13:25 “The righteous eateth to the satisfying of his soul: but the belly of the wicked shall want.”

Place these two above scriptures on your cupboard and refrigerator doors where they can be seen to remind you.

YOU can be healed of overindulgence!

Jas. 5:16 “Confess your faults one to another, and PRAY ONE FOR ANOTHER, THAT YE MAY BE HEALED. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.”

As you are tempted to eat those things which will put more weight on, pray for your partner. Ask your partner to pray for you in the same way as I will outline here, when she also is tempted to eat that which is not necessary. As you continue to pray, one for another, you will both be delivered and healed from these overpowering desires which only the enemy causes you to have when you belong to Jesus. As you persist, you will note weight reduction will be evident.

As you pray, do thusly:

1. Bind the spirit of Desire, Indulgence, or Gluttony, *in the name of Jesus Christ* (Matthew 16:19; 18:18).
2. Loose the spirit of Self-Discipline, Will-Power, or Temperance *in the name of Jesus Christ*.
3. Remember, thank the Lord and praise Him daily for the overcoming power to resist the devil and thank Him for the Word being made flesh in your body and soul as you quote the scripture keys emphasized in this exhortation.

The enemy would like to ruin your body because it is the temple of the living God (II Corinthians 6:16). Therefore, he is the culprit giving you the desires to eat the things which are weakening your body. When you are

tired, sick and unhealthy, you are not fit and available for God's use. So many Christians are heavier than they should be because the enemy is buffeting them in this way. Physical infirmities relating to obesity are not being criticized but can be healed also.

When you take heed to this exhortation, you are causing your spirit to reign in ascendancy over your soul. The desires of the flesh are in the soul area where the enmity of the flesh works to destroy the temple of the living God. The tools which our Lord gave us for this battle are found in Binding and Loosing, not Deliverance. You are not being possessed when you cannot resist the temptation to eat in a gluttonous way, you are giving in to carnal desires. See: Luke 21:34. Surfeiting is overindulgence in anything.

It is a battle in the flesh to overcome in this area; but when you do, the joy of the Lord is truly your strength, for you have 'resisted the enemy, so he must flee' because you have submitted unto God in obeying His Word. May the Lord be with you in a mighty way and give you the overcoming power which you need to carry through!
